**Job Title:** Kitchen Help, Bus Person, Server, Hostess.

**Work Description:** You will be assigned a position upon your arrival dependent upon the needs of your employer and the best fit for you. You should be prepared to do any of the following positions:

**Kitchen Help:** Kitchen Help may include washing and re-shelving soiled dish ware and glassware, emptying garbage, sweeping and mopping floors, wiping down food service tables, cleaning appliances, chopping vegetables, and assisting the cook. The kitchen area, at times will have high humidity and temperatures.

**Bus Person:** this may include clearing and setting tables, mopping floors, helping the wait staff, refilling water glasses, working in the kitchen.

**Server:** These positions require that you speak excellent English and include waiting on customers, answering questions, writing down lunch and dinner orders, serving food, dealing with U.S. currency, and possibly setting and clearing tables.

**Hostess:** Depending on your English level and the needs of your employer, you may be asked to do hostess duties. Hostess duties may include helping customers, seating them, taking their orders, using a cash register, keep hostess station clean etc.

**Note:** although you will be filling support staff positions, English will still be a fundamental part of your job and so you are encouraged to practice your speaking and comprehension skills as best you can before arriving.

All of these positions require standing, bending and walking as well as the possible use of chemical cleaning products.

You may be asked to assist in other areas at your employer's request so please be flexible.

**Uniform/Dress Code:** You should always maintain a neat and clean appearance on the job. You will be required to wear a uniform. You should bring black shorts/skirts/pants and black slip-resistant shoes. You will need to purchase a shirt from your employer for \$10.

**Salary Per Hour:** Tipped positions will start at \$2.13 plus tips. If you work in the kitchen, you will be paid \$7.25. If you work as a host staff, you will be paid \$7.25.

**Overtime Information:** Time and a half.

**Work Hours:** You will usually work about 7 hours/day, 5-6 days/week.

**Accommodation Cost:** 120 per Week

**Accommodation Description:** You will be living in an apartment with other students and you will be sharing a room with one other student. The apartment has a full kitchen available, a living room, and a shared bathroom. You will be responsible for your own meals. A grocery store is located a block away from your housing. Meals will be available at the restaurant for 50% off thirty minutes before or after each work shift. The housing is located a short walk to work and to the beach - please bring sunscreen! Your employer provides sheets and towels. **As soon as you arrive, you must be prepared to pay \$450 for the first month of rent.**

**When you arrive to the area, your employer will arrange for your transportation to Avon. This will cost \$50 per person.**
