Job Descriptions: You will be working at an amusement park. You will be assigned a position based upon the needs of your employer at the time of your arrival. You should be prepared to be a Ride Operator, but may also work in any of the following positions, as your employer will place you wherever they need you: Food Service Operators or Games/Arcade Operators.

We strive for Excellent Customer Service in all employees. Employees are expected to have a positive attitude and fulfill all customer service expectations, including, but not limited to: greeting, smiling and "high fives" to guests.

Salary: \$9.10 per hour. Overtime hours available on occasion.

Work Hours: You will usually 6 - 7 hours per day, 5 days per week. You will be guaranteed 32 hours of work per week. Park is only open through September 7th. Please contact InterExchange in mid-August if you need work after this date.

Housing Information: Housing will be \$65 per week. Usually you will be sharing a room with 3-4 other students. Co-ed apartments are available for couples. The apartments have a kitchen and bathroom. You will be responsible for your own meals. You will be living in a housing complex with international students living in the apartments around you. SECURITY DEPOSIT - In order to hold a place for you in our summer program, a \$130.00 security deposit must be sent to us by May 1st, 2015. Please do not wait for visa approval to send your deposit. We may no longer have a place for you if you miss this deadline. If you are unable to obtain a visa your deposit will be returned to you.

Uniform: You will be required to wear a uniform, which will be provided. Women may wear up to three earrings per ear. Men may wear one earring only. Men's hair should be neatly trimmed on the sides and in the back, and may extend downward on the back of the head to the middle of the collar. No ponytails are allowed for men. Tattoos are not permitted if visible when wearing a company issued uniform. No visible tattoos. No tattoos allowed on mid arm, lower arm, hands, neck or head. No visible body piercings allowed while working. Natural hair color required. No extreme styles for hair or jewelry. No plugs or spikes allowed.

PLACEMENT EXAMS: All employees must take and pass a pre-placement exam upon arrival and not passing the pre-placement tests will result in not getting placed in a job with our company. Tests are based on your job placement and may include: illegal drug screen, back exam and math test.

Area Description: This amusement park is located on the beautiful coastal beach of Santa Cruz, California.

There is a town near the park with restaurants, bars, cafes, shops, etc. In your free time you can enjoy surfing, relaxing on the beach, hiking, playing volleyball, and exploring the town of Santa Cruz. Santa Cruz is located about 70 miles south of San Francisco. Please note that many students find the area colder than expected. Mornings and evenings can get as cold as 10 degrees Celsius.
